PROCEEDING OF GOVERNMENT OF KARNATAKA

Sub: Recognition of FR.Muller's Charitable Institutions as a Religious Minority Educational Institution-Reg.

- Read: 1. Judgement dtd.4.2.93 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Unnikrishnan J.P. & Others.
2. Interim orders of the Supreme Court of India dtd.14.5.93, 21.5.93, and 7.6.93 respectively.

PREAMBLE:

The Managements of several private professional institutions had filed Writ Petitions in the Supreme Court pleading that, since they are minority educational institutions, the decision of the Supreme Court in J.F.Unnikrishnan Vs. State of Andhra Pradesh, etc., or Rules and Orders made pursuant thereto do not apply to them. When some of these writ petitions came up for hearing, the Supreme Court gave an interim orders on 14.9.1993 and again on 24.5.93 and 7.6.93 read at (2) above, allowing for regulation of 50% of the intake in such institutions by the petitioners to admit candidates belonging to the particular religious or linguistic minority, strictly on the basis as further spelt out in the Order dtd.14.5.93. It was made clear by the Supreme Court that this order was made on the assumption that the petitioners are minority institutions and it is open to the respondent (State) to question such status. In a further order dated 18.8.1993, read at (3) above, the Supreme Court continued the above interim order with the modification however, that such interim order shall be applicable only to those institutions which are found to be minority educational institutions on verification by the Government, and not to those who are not found to be minority educational institutions on such verification.

In pursuance of the order dtd.18.8.1993 in Writ Petition (Civil) No.598 of 1993 etc of the Supreme Court, it was felt expedient to constitute a Committee to examine and verify the contentions of institutions claiming to be Minority Educational Institutions and submit recommendations in this behalf to Government. Accordingly, a Committee consisting of (1) Commissioner & Secretary to Govt., Education Department, (2) Commissioner & Secretary to Govt., Department of Health & Family Welfare and (3) The Secretary to Government, Department of Law & Parliamentary Affairs respectively was constituted vide Govt.Order dtd.26.8.93 read at(4) above.

The Director of Technical Education and Member-Secretary, Common Entrance Test Committee, in his letter dtd:27.8.93 read at (5) above, invited the representatives of the concerned institutions to meet the Committee referred to above, if they so desire, on 1.9.93 at 2.00 p.m. in the Committee Room, 1st Floor, M.S. Building, Bangalore alongwith necessary documents like original Deed of Trust, Certificate of Registration etc.

Accordingly, the representatives of Fr. Muller's Charitable Institutions, Mangalore appeared before the Committee and presented the case along with the necessary documents in support of their claim for minority status.

The Committee examined the documents produced by the representation of Fr. Muller's Charitable Institutions, Mangalore and also the various relevant factors in regard to the claim of minority status made by the above institution and submitted its recommendations to Government.

Government has considered the recommendations of the Committee. Accordingly, the following orders are passed:

ORDER NO. ED 104 TANIVI 93(1-10), BANGALORE, DATED:14.9.1993.

The claim and contention of Father Muller's Charitable Institutions to recognise the educational institutions run by it as Minority Educational Institutions is examined.

The Fr. Muller's Charitable Institution has been registered under the Societies Registration Act in 1960. It is claimed that the institution is a religious minority institution sponsored by the Catholic Diocese of Mangalore. The Memorandum of Association lists the objects of the society, which include among other things, promotion of education, medicine, surgery and nursing.

It is not indicated in these objects whether the society or the institutions under the society are being run to subservise the interest of the Christian Religious Minority Community in Karnataka.

The Society has established a College of Nursing in 1987. It was observed from the documents produced by the society that neither in their application to Government for grant of permission to start the Nursing College, nor in the application to the Mangalore University for affiliation has it been indicated that this is a religious minority institution being run for the minority community.

The details of admission to the college indicate that in 1992-93 100% of the seats were allotted to Christian candidates, in 1991-92 48 out of 50 students and in 1990-91, 38 out of 41 students, were allotted to Christian students.

In view of the fact that the institution is run by the Catholic Diocese of Mangalore, which is the recognised representative of the Catholic Community in that region, and the rules make specific reference to the tenets of the Catholic religion, as well as the high percentage in the total intakes of students belonging to the minority concerned, (as high as 100% in 1992-93) Government is of the view that this Institution is eligible to be recognised as a Minority Educational Institution.

Accordingly, Government is pleased to recognise Fr. Muller's Charitable Institutions, Mangalore as a Minority Educational Institution. This is subject to review again in the light of the judgement of the Hon'ble Supreme Court being delivered after the hearing on 22.9.1993.




