- The College has received research grants from the Various funding bodies and conducts research projects in collaboration with other national institutions.
- A few of the modern age instruments currently used in the department for the assessment, treatment and research in the field of speech, language and hearing disorders includes V.HIT - Video Head Impulse Test, VNG- Video Nystagmography, VEMP - Vestibular Evoked Myogenic Potential, ABR - Auditory Brainstem Responses, VRA - Visual Reflex Audiometry (for pediatric population), Dr. Speech, Vaghi, Stroboscopy, MDVP – Multidimensional Voice Profile.

COURSE DURATION:

- B.ASLP (Bachelor in Audiology and Speech Language Pathology) is a 4 Years (3 Year – 6 semesters + 1 year Internship) degree course.
- Each semester will be of a minimum period of 16 weeks, excluding examination duration.
- The First, Third and Fifth semester of the BASLP course will commence, latest by the last week of June.
- Similarly the Second, Fourth and Sixth semesters will commence in the last week of November.
- At the end of these semesters there shall be examinations, followed by vacation for students.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:

- **Father Muller Medical College is a religious minority Institution; hence all admissions are governed as per the religious minority Institution status.**
- The candidate applying for admission to B.ASLP program should have passed 10+2 examination or an equivalent examination conducted by the Pre University Board of Education of the respective State Government securing a minimum of 50% marks. Relaxation in the qualifying marks shall be as per rules and regulations of respective University / State/UTs or Central Government.
- The applicant/candidate who has passed the two year pre-university examination conducted by the pre-university board of Karnataka or any other examination considered as equivalent there to by Mangalore University with following subjects combination - Physics, Chemistry, Biology as compulsory subjects and any one of the subjects like Mathematics / Computer Science / Statistics / Electronics / Psychology as optional subject to approval of University..
- The candidate should have completed 17 years of age as on December 31 of the year of admission and shall not be older than 25 years on the 1 July of the year of admission.

COMMENCEMENT OF COURSE:

- The course commences as per the date prescribed by Mangaluru University. The exact date will be communicated by the Institution every year.

GENERAL REGULATIONS:

- Every student is required to familiarize himself/herself with the rules laid down in the prospectus and also formulated and announced by the Management from time to time.
- Every student should possess the identity card issued by the college which should be produced whenever asked for, especially when dealing with the office and library.
- Students should not absent themselves from the classes, practical's, and examinations without the prior permission from the principal. Such absence without permission may lead to disciplinary actions.
- Sexual Harassment will not be tolerated. The college will promptly investigate such allegations and take appropriate action as each individual situation warrants.
- Students are advised to maintain the cleanliness of classroom and environmental awareness by keeping the campus clean, green and plastic free.
- Catholic students are advised to participate in all the Religious activities organized on the campus.
- Students are not permitted to use mobile phones during the class hours & clinicals. Students are not permitted to play or listen to music using mobile phones or any other electronic devices in the college campus.

- Every student must respect the members of the staff.
- Grievances if any may be brought to the notice of the grievance redressal cell.

- Students shall not indulge, either individually or collectively, in any form of activity that will bring down the good name of the Institution or their profession.

- Students are required to dress modestly while attending the college and should wear uniform on all the clinical postings.
- Institution follows strict dress code adhering to the rules and regulations of the Institution.
- Students will be oriented regarding rules and regulations like dress code, code of conduct etc prior to the commencement of the classes.

DISCIPLINE:

- To evoke dignity and decorum benefitting the profession they have chosen, all students are required to be dressed neatly and modestly, by wearing the prescribed uniform.
- Students are expected to exhibit dignified and mature behaviour with fellow students and the patients.
- Any breach of discipline shall be suitably dealt with. Serious lapses of discipline and character shall render the student's name liable to be struck off the roll of the College.
- If, in the opinion of the Principal, a student is not likely to benefit by continuing in the College or is considered to be detrimental to the best interest of the Institutions, the Management may order such student to leave the College. Fees paid by the students will not be refunded in such cases. The Management's decision in this regard shall be final and binding.
- The Management reserves the right of making any addition to or omission from or alteration in the above rules and regulations including fee structure without prior notice.
- For all legal matters/disputes arising out of provisions of this prospectus, the court of jurisdiction will be that of Mangalore only.
